Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act Section 18004(e)

In accordance with Section 18004(e) of the Coronavirus Aid Relief and Economic Security Act, Jarvis Christian College acknowledges the following:

- 1. The institution has signed and returned to the Department of Education a Certificate and Agreement form, which ensures that Jarvis Christian College intends to use Emergency Grant Aid directly to eligible students.
- 2. The Emergency Financial Aid Grants are to assist students with expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus (including eligible expenses under a student's cost of attendance, such as food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and child care).
- 3. The total amount of funds received by Jarvis Christian College from the Department of Education to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students is \$4,439,623.
- 4. As of March 31, 2022, the amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students is \$3,171,309.
- 5. As of March 31, 2022, the amount of Institutional Aid distributed to students is \$91,480.
- 6. The estimated number of students eligible to receive Emergency Grant Aid is approximately six hundred eleven (611).
- 7. As of March 31, 2022, approximately five hundred and ninety-eight (598) students have received Emergency Grant Aid.
- 8. The methodology for allocating and disbursing Emergency Financial Aid Grants is as follows:
 - a. Based on unmet need as determined by student ISIRs from their FASFA
 - b. Five-tier allocation based on students' estimated family contribution with one tier designated for special/unusual circumstances.
- 9. Students must:
 - a. Be enrolled at Jarvis Christian College as of March 13, 2020.
 - b. Eligible for Title IV funds
 - c. Complete an Emergency Grant Aid Application (<u>www.jarvis.edu</u>)

Other notations:

- Students were emailed information on how to submit an application regarding Emergency Grant Aid.
- JCC website has two links in which students can check eligibility requirements and apply online to receive aid.
- All students will receive funds in their Herring Bank Account (either check, debit card deposit, or direct deposit).
