BY STARTING YOUR COLLEGE CAREER EARLY YOU CAN...

Earn 13 Credits 

Earn 13 college credits this summer and at least 17 college credits this fall—for a total of 30 semester credit hours—and become a sophomore by January.

\$500 Off Tuition 

Earn a \$500 tuition discount at the end of each semester (student must complete 15 credit hours, remain in good academic standing (2.00), and graduate in 4 years or less).

Earn \$4,000 Scholarship 

Students who do NOT qualify for an academic scholarship can obtain a \$4,000 scholarship by earning a 3.0 G.P.A. in the summer program.

Save Up to 50% Off Regular Tuition 

Cost savings is calculated based on tuition, room & board, for the fall/spring semesters.
