


# Online Access Information for Distance Learners

## The Online Catalog

The Olin Library has an excellent automated library system. The Library Corporation (TLC) has Library-Solution, TLC's integrated, Oracle-based library automation system. Library-Solution is an integrated client/server system. It is a system utilizing a completely browser-based OPAC interface. Patrons and staff use the same interface whether accessing the OPAC from the library, homes, college, or offices. This system allows unlimited access to the OPAC. JSTOR (short for Journal Storage) is an online system for archiving academic journals, founded in 1995. It provides its member institutions full-text searches of digitized back issues of several hundred well-known journals, dating back to 1665.


